* Tetragon Financial Management L.P., the investment manager of TFG and TFGMF, is currently in the process of withdrawing its investment adviser registration under the U.S. Investment Advisers Act of 1940 (the “Advisers Act”) and such withdrawal should be effective in the near future. It is currently expected that Tetragon Financial Management L.P., will re-register in 2012 once the development and implementation of legislation regarding the requirements of the Advisers Act have been clarified.
